Denham Village Green

Denham Village Green has always been the local landmark for the Parish. The Village Green Trust was established in 1952 by the Rev. Herbert Ward and the Parish Council is now the sole Trustee. The Village Green makes a valuable amenity contribution to the community and enhances the character of the Village. Attractive trees, many with preservation orders and five memorial benches allow for quiet enjoyment within this conservation area.

Over the years, the Parish Council has been supporting the upkeep of the Village Green keeping the grass neatly mown. It has identified that the benches and railings are now in need of repair and maintenance to keep them in a safe condition for the enjoyment of the whole of the parish.

The Council will be writing to residents in the near future to ask for their support to help keep the Village Green in good condition and looking pleasant and welcoming for both residents and visitors.
