The Parish Council agreed the last stages at its' October Council meeting to submit the Denham Neighbourhood Plan to Buckinghamshire Council. A Planning Inspector will be appointed and our Plan will be scrutinised, it will then be put forward to residents for a referendum vote to adopt the Plan.

Once adopted the Neighbourhood Plan will become planning policy in Denham and will help protect the unique characteristics of the area. We hope that the Plan will go to referendum in May 2021. We would like to thank all the residents, volunteers and Councillors who have put in an incredible amount of time and energy to ensure that Denham is protected as much as possible in the years to come.
